Product comparison

Parameter	 Zoho QEngine	 Postman
Product-specific testing needs	End-to-end workflows including web (UI), mobile, API, and regression testing are addressed on one platform.	Primarily focused on API testing, while web and mobile testing require additional tools.
Code maintenance	Unified scripting via Deluge simplifies maintenance across web, mobile, and APIs.	Scripts must be written in JavaScript for APIs, and scaling beyond APIs increases complexity.
Managing test cases	Centralized test case management across modules is supported with versioning.	Collections help manage APIs, but end-to-end testing is fragmented across multiple tabs, making test management difficult.
Creating and sharing reports	Centralized and built-in dashboards with pass/fail insights are available, with easy sharing access and visibility across teams.	Basic reporting is available for each test execution, but advanced reporting requires integrations or exports.
Load balancing	Load balancing is managed internally via cloud and local agents (hybrid) for distributed execution.	This requires external setup for handling high-scale API execution.
